Statement of Position on Fire, Health, and Safety

Approved by the Grand Lodge June 23rd, 2004

Approved by the 157th Annual Convention of Theta Delta Chi, August 6th, 2004

WHEREAS, The Grand Lodge of Theta Delta Chi and its Charges believe that fire, health, and safety are of the utmost importance to our members;

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Grand Lodge of Theta Delta Chi and its Charges that the following policies be formally adopted by consent of the 157th Annual Convention:

1. That all Charge or colony houses (rent, or owned) meet all local, and university fire and health codes and standards.
2. That all Charges or colonies shall have posted by common phones the emergency numbers for fire, police, and ambulance services.
3. That all Charges and colonies shall have posted evacuation routes on the back of the door of each sleeping room.
4. That all Charges and colonies shall comply with the engineering recommendation as reported by the insurance company selected by Theta Delta Chi.
5. The possession and/or use of firearms or explosive devices of any kind within the confines and premises of the Charge or colony house is expressly forbidden.
6. That smoking within a Charge or colony house is strongly discouraged.
